In detail, SHINRYO commits to:

1. recognizing safety and health at work as an integral part of its business;
2. achieving a high level of occupational safety and health performance, in compliance with legal and contractual requirements;
3. providing adequate and appropriate resources;
4. ensuring that all its staff and workers recognize the management of safety and health being one of their prime duties and responsibilities;
5. understanding the needs of all its staff and workers and providing effective communication channels;
6. consulting all its staff and workers so as to secure their commitment to the policy and its implementation;
7. ensuring that all its staff and workers have received appropriate training and therefore they are competent in carrying out their duties;
8. striving to achieve the target of reportable accident frequency rate of not over 0.4 (/1,000,000 man-hours);
9. notifying all its staff and workers after periodic review and any revisions to the Policy; and
10. ensuring that the Policy is reviewed not less than once a year.
